## **Structural steel specialist T T J builds order book to S\$200 million with new contracts of S\$19 million**

**SINGAPORE - 7 February 2012** – T T J Holdings Limited (“T T J” or together with its subsidiaries, the “Group”) today announced that it has secured approximately S\$19 million in new contracts, increasing its order book to date to a robust S\$200 million. As part of its work scope, T T J will supply structural steelworks, civil defence shelter doors and other services for a diversified mix of commercial, industrial and public transport projects in Singapore. These latest projects are expected to be completed between FY2012 and FY2013.

On the commercial front, the projects secured by the Group include the fabrication and delivery of king posts for the conservation of Capitol Building & Stamford House and a commercial & office building located at 146 Market Street.

T T J was also awarded two more contracts along a prime area in the heart of Orchard Road, which comprise additional work for the proposed redevelopment of Specialists' Centre/Hotel Phoenix/Orchard Emerald. The additional work comprises the supply, fabrication and installation of structural steel crowns at the top of towers of the new buildings, as well as civil defence shelter doors at the new entrance of the existing MRT Station as part of the redevelopment. These contracts follow the Group's initial contract awarded in January 2011 to construct the overhead pedestrian steel link bridge at Specialists' Centre/Hotel Phoenix, and attest to T T J's strength as a quality steelwork provider.

Besides these, T T J was awarded a contract to supply and install civil defence shelter doors for another two MRT stations as part of Contract 913 of the MRT Downtown Line 2. With this, the Group has effectively secured contracts to supply civil defence shelter doors for all the stations in

the MRT Downtown Line 2 that require such doors, underscoring its market leadership in this segment.

The Group also secured a new contract to supply, fabricate and install structural steelwork to their existing customer, Hitachi Plant Technologies Ltd for a new chemical plant at Jurong Island. T T J has also undertaken structural steelworks for the complete design-and-build of the accompanying warehouse. This project further cements T T J's foothold as one of the key suppliers of structural steelwork on Jurong Island, which is a strategic industrial location to leading global petroleum, petrochemicals and specialty chemicals companies.

Says T T J's Chairman and Managing Director, Mr Teo Hock Chwee (张福水): "T T J has kicked off 2012 on a strong note with these new projects. Our current order book of S\$200 million is very robust and will keep us busy till FY2013. In addition, we have a relatively busy tender book comprising bids for a mix of public and private sector commercial, industrial and institutional projects and public transport development projects. We believe that T T J is in a strong position to capitalize on opportunities in Singapore's construction sector and we remain confident of the growth outlook of the Group this year."
